\*\*Note: Also effective July 1, 2008, the Post Partum Visit fee 14094 has been expanded to include all forms of delivery – vaginal and C-Section, both elective and emergency. The 14094 is not billable by the physician who performed the C-Section as the 6 weeks post operative care is included in the surgical fee.
